**LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #10 Modern Tale**

This gelding has been knocking on the door in his last few starts, and though he hasn't won in roughly a year, he has been right there recently. This isn't the type of horse I would normally take for that reason, but I was so impressed by his last race. After a slow start, he rallied very gamely between horses and finished an impressive third in his second start with blinkers. He should get plenty of pace to run at today at a nice price.
