He's now second off the claim for Victor Barboza and should run even stronger today.

**LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #1 All in Stew Oui**

This colt by Twirling Candy ran solidly last time out in his first start for a claiming tag, and in just his second start on turf. He gets a slight turnback in distance today to the mile, and I think should sit a nice ground saving trip from the inside post going two turns on the grass. His races, in my opinion, are much stronger than they might appear on paper, and he has been facing good company.
