Not to mention, he ran on soft turf two starts back, which was clearly not to his liking. Last time, he finished a good second behind A Thread of Blue, who looks like a real quality turf horse for trainer Kieran McLaughlin. I think that this colt will continue to move forward under Chris Landeros, who has been riding in top form lately.
