With natural speed and getting a slight drop on the claiming scale, it looks like this gelding is the one to beat in here. Leading jockey Edgard Zayas knows this horse very well, and will once again stay aboard. The last two races, which were both sprinting on the dirt, were very solid performances, and I think that he meets a softer field today and should hopefully be able to dictate the pace on top of it.

LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #8 Oblio's Wish

The first time starter from the Todd Pletcher barn, Quick Point, will likely take most of the money in here and very well could be the next maiden winner in this field. However, that should make for some nice prices within the rest of the group, including Oblio's Wish, who is the most tested in the field, already having 7 starts under her belt. She has only ever run on the turf once, and it was two starts back against tougher in special weight company, where she ran a very good third behind a repeat winner. Getting a class drop today and back on the grass, she's one to look at with good value.
