Trainer Chad Brown is 32% win winners last out on the turf after a lay-off of more than 180 days.

LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #1 Eric the Salesman

This gelding will be switching back to the turf today, and his last turf race two starts back was relatively solid at a big price and when stuck with a far outside post. He also got a big jockey change to Tyler Gaffalione last out, who will stick aboard today and has never ridden this horse on the grass before. This Paynter gelding will be a good price today.
