In addition, I think she meets the right kind of field today to make it two wins in a row, as she has been very consistent and impressive.

LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #1 She's Right Again

On paper, it appears that this race is lacking in early speed, and I can envision a scenario in which She's Right Again sends from the inside post and never looks back. The Nagle barn is one that often flies beneath the radar but does a good job and can yield some high paying winners. This horse won nicely last time out at Tampa, and has Beyer Speed Figures that absolutely put her in the mix.
