LONGSHOT: Race 5 - #7 Notcho Daddy

I'm taking a shot against the likely favorite, Honolulu Express, and I think you'll find value on pretty much everyone else. Notcho Daddy is switching back to the turf, where he has only competed once, but it was against tougher than what he faces today and he finished fourth, showing early speed. Javier Castellano has the call for trainer Mike Dini, and this gelding should be a nice price.
